TASK 4 (1.5 pts of the Final Mark)

Each group must prepare two slides on one of the flows of Globalization

- a) One with the formulation of a simple thesis. Two (hopefully clear) *Lord of Rings*-inspired examples follow:
 - a. "Capital-poor countries (like Gondor and Rivendell benefitted from intense abroad investment"
 - b. "Natural resource-rich regions (like Mordor and Moria) were harmed by intercontinental trade of agrarian goods".
- b) Other with one or two materials (i.e.: map, graph, table, diagram) documenting your thesis flows during the First Globalization (1820-1914).

Parts are assigned as follows:

International Labour Flows	B and D
International Capital Flows	C and E

Presentations will be made by one student chosen by the lecturer for each group.

Marks will reflect the slides, more than the presentation.
