

Knowledge Assessment Regime

Academic Year: 2026/2027, 1st Semester

Regular Evaluation Period

Assessment during the regular evaluation period consists of a project and an individual written exam. The final grade (**FG**) is calculated as the weighted average of these two components:

$$FG = (0.40 \times \text{Project} + 0.60 \times \text{Written Exam})$$

The grades for both the project and the written exam range from 0 to 20 points. In the written exam, students must obtain a minimum score of **7 points** to qualify for evaluation in the regular period.

Retake & Defense Policies

- **Retake Period:** During the retake period, only the grade obtained in the final exam taken at that date will be considered for evaluation.
- **Grade Defense:** If the final grade exceeds 18 points, the student may be required to take an additional oral or written exam to defend the grade.

Exam Rules & Consultation Policy

Open-book Policy: Written exams will allow limited consultation of one A4 sheet (two sides) with content freely prepared by the student. Any type of standard calculator may be used during the written exams.
