KNOWLEDGE ASSESSMENT REGIME

Assessment during the regular period consists of a project and an individual written exam. The final grade (FG) is calculated as the weighted average of these two components:

 $FG = (0.40 \times Project + 0.60 \times Written Exam),$

where the grades for the project and written exam range from 0 to 20 points. In the written exam, students must obtain a minimum score of 7 points to qualify for evaluation in the regular period.

During the retake period, only the grade obtained in the final exam taken at that date will be considered.

If the final grade exceeds 18 points, the student may be required to take an additional exam to defend the grade.

Open-book policy: Written exams will allow limited consultation of one A4 sheet (two sides) with content freely prepared by the student. Any type of calculator may be used during the written exams.
