Account Analysis

Troia Hotels is a resort area that is particularly busy from mid May through mid September (<u>http://www.troiahotels.com/</u>).

The firm was clearly insolvent and creditors forced the firm to go to a formal bankruptcy process in 1993. The Commercial Court appointed a Trustee for representing the interests of the creditors. The Trustee was interested in analysing the fixed and variable costs to more accurately estimate the break even-analysis and understanding the economic gap required for vitalising the firm.

- 7. Soap, shampoo and other toiletries in the rooms
- 8. F&B (Food and Beverage)
- 9. Energy
- 10. Garden and beaches maintenance
