HOW IS THIS CURRICULAR UNIT ORGANIZED?

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS CURRICULAR UNIT?

- To give 2nd year MFinance students:
 - **Information about** the different types of Masters' Final Work (**MFW**) they can choose from:
 - Dissertation;
 - Project;
 - Internship/Traineeship Report.
 - Fundamental **knowledge of Ethics and Professional Standards**, according to:
 - ISEG's Learning Goals in the context of the **AACSB Accreditation** process;
 - The **CFA curriculum**, given our MFinance's status of CFA University Affiliated Program.
 - **Pressure** to start working on the MFW – the sooner the better!

WHAT IS THE EVALUATION/ASSESSMENT SYSTEM LIKE?

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- **There is no Final Grade** in this curricular unit: its credits, **12 ECTS, accrue to the MFW's 30 ECTS**, as our Seminars are seen as preparation for the MFW. So, **your final grade on the MFW corresponds to 42 ECTS** of your final MFinance grade.
- **BUT first you need to be Approved by me in this curricular unit E&RMiF.**
 - This means you must actively participate, attend classes on Thursdays, and prepare an MFW proposal
 - THE DETAILS ARE GIVEN IN THE NEXT SLIDE.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO TO BE APPROVED IN THIS CURRICULAR UNIT?

- FOR APPROVAL IN THIS CURRICULAR UNIT A STUDENT MUST:
 - **ATTEND THE CLASSES OF 22 NOVEMBER 2018 AND OF 29 NOVEMBER 2018 – MANDATORY!**
 - These sessions are very important for ISEG's AACSB accreditation, because we assess the "Technical Skills" and "Ethical Perspective" components of our MFinance: IF IT'S IMPORTANT FOR ISEG, IT'S IMPORTANT FOR YOU.
 - **ATTEND A MINIMUM OF 7 WEEKLY SESSIONS – BUT PLEASE ATTEND THEM ALL!**
 - IDEALLY STUDENTS SHOULD ATTEND ALL SESSIONS, OF COURSE.
 - **SUBMIT AN MFW PROPOSAL UNTIL 13 DECEMBER 2018.**

AACSB ACCREDITATION @ E&RMiF

- In this 2nd Year curricular unit we assess the learning process of 2 Learning Goals (LGs) of our School, according to AACSB's Accreditation process.
- AACSB requires that our students demonstrate they have learned what we say they should learn. **So we need to prove you know.** It is a process called AoL (Assurance of Learning).

 - **Technical Skills:** with a short questionnaire of generic multiple choice finance questions.
- It is not you who is being assessed, it is ALL OF US. Take it seriously! Again: "If it matters to ISEG, it matters to you".
