SESSION #1

- 1. Read REAL OPTION VALUE, CH 1 (pages 4-11) and CH 2 (pages 12-22), and CH 3. Do Exercises 2.1, 2.2, 2.3 with a calculator, and Exercises 3.1, 3.2 and 3.3.
- 2. A primary objective during the first session is for students to organize report groups based on their interests and backgrounds. A RO_19 Report will focus on one enterprise or issue, noting the relevant real options, choosing 1-2 appropriate models, obtaining some input data, proposing strategic actions for management based on your analysis. Suitable projects in the past have started with a CASE, and then added recent data, interpreting the new application of the model. For the first case-project, the SWN 10-K for 2018 is available from 1 March 2019, so the figures can be usefully updated. Depending on class size, groups of five, everyone in the group receives the same grade.
- 3. Some may prefer the convenience of doing a case, where all data is provided, and the grade is individual.
- 4. There is too much material in the first "package" for any human student to absorb, so scan the three cases, decide which is most interesting for you.
