

THE CFA CHARTER

- Recognized by regulatory bodies in many countries as a proxy for meeting certain licensing requirements
- The Comissão do Mercado de Valores Mobiliários (CMVM) recognizes the CFA charter as fulfillment of the qualifications needed as an investment adviser (Regulation CMVM nº3/2010 Artº10 2)
- Many universities around the world incorporate the CFA curriculum into their degree programs and apply waivers from graduate school entrance exams (GMAT) and university courses






