TASK 4 (1.33 pts of the Final Mark)

- a) One with materials (ie: maps, graphs, tables, diagrams) documenting the size and/or direction of economic flows during the First Globalization (1820-1914).
- b) Another with the formulation of an argument that your materials support, as in these fictitious examples: “the flow of capitals between Atlantida and Utopia were beneficial to the former but not to the latter”; “trade benefitted most absolute-advantage countries”.
