Open Questions cover the same topics (i.e., 1st and 2nd Globalizations and policy changes) and will be close (but not equal) to those debated in Task 8. Marking will replicate the standard applied in the Minitest, i.e. valuing the capacity to build a coherent argument and support it with concrete information.

Multiple-Choice Questions focus on more concrete events and institutions. Examples:

1. **The post-war plans designed during World War II under American leadership**
 - a. Prioritized freedom in international trade
 - b. Included the GATT and the Marshall Plan
 - c. Were carefully thought to stimulate international capital mobility, unlike what had happened after 1918
 - d. Included the Social Market Economy and capital flows liberalization

2. **Amongst the causes for growth in international trade during the First Globalization, we find**
 - a. The removal of institutional barriers to capital flows after 1870.
 - b. An international order that ensured peace amongst Great Powers (since 1900)
 - c. Voluntary openness of economic borders (since the 1820s)
 - d. Bilateral trade agreements in Europe and gold standard since the 1820s
