TASK 1 (the Final Mark)

At the 2009 Tawney Lecture (Text 3), Robert C. Allen asks “Why was the Industrial Revolution British?”

After considering other factors, especially institutions, the author shifts the focus to the supply- and demand-side incentives for technological innovation that exist in Great Britain.
