

## Survival Models and Life Contingencies – online examinations

The exams will be delivered according to the general instructions established for the non-face-to-face exams at ISEG. A few more specific instructions follow, which essentially replicate the experience carried out with the so-called ‘mock exam’. These instructions refer to both Part I and Part II.

1. The exam will be delivered in a TEAMS session. Students will have cameras on and microphones unmuted, in order to enable invigilation.
2. The session will start ten minutes (five minutes in Part II) before the start time for the examination. In these ten (five) minutes the roll call will be done.
3. At the scheduled start time, the questions paper will be uploaded to TEAMS, in pdf format.
4. Students will have two hours (one hour in Part II) to answer the questions. Each student must write his/her name at the beginning of each page and use a dark colour ballpoint pen. Students should also organize their answers in a legible and orderly manner and clearly identify the question that corresponds to each answer. Answers should be written in loose sheets, to make photography/digitalization of the test easier (Part I). Part II will be typed into Excel.
5. An approved calculator and *Formulae and Tables for Actuarial Examinations (the 2002 edition of the Formulae and Tables)* may be used.
6. After completing their work in Part I, students will take photos of all the sheets, save them in a file or a folder named ‘yourname’SolPartI, and upload it to Aquila. In Part II they will upload the Excel spreadsheet named ‘yourname’SolPartII.
