TASK 1b

Each group will prepare the presentation of two of the following illustrations resorted to by the author of Text 1.

Agr - agrarian crops (pp. 13-14)
Bif – Bifurcation Theory (p. 5)
INS - N and S Italy
Neo - The Neolithic Revolution
Q&Q - Quantity and Quality
TIP - The Inuit People

RECOMMENDATIONS

Each group will prepare a short exposition about how **two** of these illustrations explain the **argument** of the text, but will only explain **one** (at the discretion of the lecturer). Parts are assigned as follows:

GROUP A – INS + Bif
GROUP B – Bif + Q&Q
GROUP C – Q&Q + TIP
GROUP D – Neo + INS
GROUP E – TIP + Agr
GROUP F – Agr + Bif

Presentations should be focused and straightforward.

Remember that in order to present an **argument**, it is essential to explain the **problem** that it responds to.

Groups can only use 1 slide (only with pictures, shapes, tables or graphs; no text) and speak for 5 minutes.

The work (and the marks) will be the same for all students in the group, but it is not essential that all students speak during presentations.
