KNOWLEDGE ASSESSMENT REGIME

Assessment during the Regular Assessment Period consists of three components: attendance, homework, and an individual written exam. The final grade (FG) is calculated as a weighted average of these components, according to the following formula:

$$\begin{aligned} \text{FG} = 0.70 \times \text{Written Exam} + 0.10 \times \text{Attendance} & (\text{theoretical and practical classes}) + 0.10 \\ & \times \text{Homework in theoretical classes} + 0.10 \times \text{Homework in practical classes} \end{aligned}$$

The grades for both the homework and the written exam range from 0 to 20 points.

In order to pass the course in the Regular Assessment Period, students must:

- obtain a minimum of 7 points in the written exam, and
- obtain a final grade (FG) of at least 9.5 points.

During the Resit Assessment Period, the final grade corresponds to 100% of the grade obtained in the written exam taken at that date. In order to pass the course in the Resit Assessment Period, students must obtain a minimum grade of 9.5 points in the written exam.

If the final grade exceeds 18 points, the student may be required to take an additional written and/or oral exam for grade defence.

Exam rules

Only non-programmable scientific calculators are allowed in written exams. Graphical calculators or any devices with internet access are not permitted.
